MORE ON THE CADET NURSES



I just, by luck, found your web sight. It is wonderful. The Cadet Nurses in Arkansas have been working with Ruth Sartori for a number of years, trying to get this Bill (which now is HR 2193) passed and from your web sight I learned of Anne R. Kakos and I have called her. Also, I am in

contact with Dorothy Camangian in Leonia, New Jersey, who is working with us. Last year the House leadership did not allow this legislation, HR 476, to be given a hearing in Committee, thus, this year Representative Nita Lowey reintroduced this bill as HR 2193. Currently HR 2193 is pending in the House Armed Services Committee and the Veterans' Affairs Committee. I would love to be in touch with you. I am an RN in Hot Springs, Arkansas. We do not have an organization as you do. That is great. My training was at Baptist Health School of Nursing and Allied Health at Little Rock, Arkansas, beginning in January of 1944 and I completed my three years December 31, 1947. The 240,000 young women who enlisted in the U S Cadet Nurse Corps were America's finest. I think 124,000 completed the three years. Now probably 30,000 are alive. I will be 80 years old August 1. My nursing career was in Pediatrics. I will be contacting every Cadet Nurse I can locate and asking them to contact their own Congressmen. I have a brother who lives in Grove City, Ohio and his Grandson is taking Pre-Med at Ohio State University. Small world!
