In an attempt to recapture a bit of my youth and to get some much needed exercise, I took up bicycle riding this summer. At this writing, I am still in an immovable splint, from shoulder to wrist, and have no use of my right hand or arm. (I'm right-handed, of course.) I have returned to work, with my surgeon's disapproving glances, simply because I couldn't sit in my house any longer. The doctors say they expect my recovery time could be up to a year, with lots of physical therapy. I plan on selling that evil bicycle!
